There are two Wayfinders working full-time with the Cornwall Memory Cafe Network as part of a special project, and each covers a different end of the county.

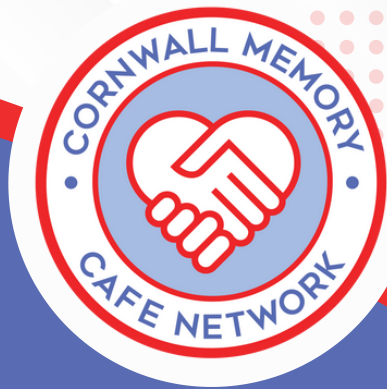
They are here to provide wellbeing support to all who attend and participate in memory cafes in their area, as well as to provide resources and practical assistance to individual cafes.
